

# Forestweb has turned out to be a success thanks to its partners:

## Växjö university – Sweden

Växjö is a new university with seven schools. The department for Forest and Wood, unit Private Forestry, runs and develops distance education for private forest owners to raise their competence and capability. In the Forestweb project this partner is responsible for the modules *Forest calculations* and *Hunting tourism* for forest owners.

## Naturbruksgymnasiet Svenljunga – Sweden

Naturbruksgymnasiet Svenljunga, located in the southwest of Sweden, is an education centre in forestry, hunting and horsemanship in upper secondary level. In addition to developing the module *Hunting tourism* for forest workers, they are also in charge of the management tasks in this project.

## IPC Groene Ruimte – Netherlands

IPC Groene Ruimte Education provides various training courses for the regular education system as well as training for trade and industry. Their courses cover a large scope of the environmental field, but also safety at work, ICT use and working conditions receive the necessary attention. IPC is in charge of the modules *Operating and machines maintenance* and *Innovation*.

## LAF – Germany

The “Lehranstalt für Forstwirtschaft” in Bad Segeberg is a forest education centre responsible for the vocational education of forest workers / trainees, for adult education regarding forestry, working security, trees, timber and nature. LAF takes care of the modules *Communication* and *Forest policy*.

## Forest Technology Centre of Catalonia – Spain

The Forest Technology Centre of Catalonia (CTFC) is an applied research, forestry training and technology transfer centre located in the Catalanian pre-Pyrenees. They have developed the courses *Occupational safety* and *Minor forest products*.

## Mendel University of Agriculture and Forestry – Czech Republic

The Department of Forest and Forest products Technology of the Mendel University in Brno provides lessons in technical disciplines mainly specialized in forestry, landscaping and wood technology. They are in charge of the modules *Natural forest management* and *Bio energy*.

## Barony College – Scotland

Barony College specialises in vocational training and education for the land-based and animal care industries. Our College estate supports dairy, beef, sheep, cereals, trout and red deer enterprises. Commercial activities also take place within our forestry and horticulture sections. *Small scale forestry*, *Walking tourism* and *Fishing tourism* are three modules they have designed.

## University of Natural Resources and Applied Life Sciences, Vienna (BOKU)

The Institute of Forest Engineering is part of the Department of Forest and Soil Sciences at the University of Natural Resources and Applied Life Sciences Vienna. The main research fields and teaching activities are timber harvesting and supply, wood biomass harvesting and supply, transport logistics of round wood, road network planning, ergonomics and work safety in forestry work. Boku takes care of the modules *Timber harvesting* and *GIS/GPS*.



## Inverde – Belgium

Inverde is a training centre for forestry, green areas and nature conservation. The key tasks of the centre are training and educational information. The module *Ecology* is their responsibility. Together with Naturbruksgymnasiet Svenljunga Inverde also takes care of the management of the project.

**Forestweb** is a website that was established with the purpose of creating a European network of knowledge on forestry and providing high quality education in sustainable forestry through internet. Here you can learn about different topics in European forestry together with equally minded people over the continent.
